Matthew 17 records for us the story of Jesus going up the mountain with his good friends Peter, James and John. There, the Bible tells us, Jesus was transfigured before them. A remarkable transformation took place before their very eyes. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. The Biblical Greek word used for this transformation process is *metamorphosis*. Amazingly, it's the same word used by Paul in 2 Corinthians 3:18 which speaks of followers of Jesus being transformed into his likeness with ever increasing glory, which comes from the Lord. Romans 12 urges us to offer our bodies as living sacrifices, as a spiritual act of worship. As we do this very thing, submitting our lives to God, there is a metamorphosis that takes place in our lives. God is in the business of changing us from what we were to what we will ultimately be in Him. Our series through February and March will take us on a journey exploring what this metamorphosis looks like in everyday life. – Nick Scott

MPC Christian Formation Short Courses in 2017

We have taken several bold initiatives in redesigning the Christian Formation short courses to be offered in 2017. There will be some half-day seminars with



engaging keynote presenters, together with mid-week short courses that focus upon practical, Christian living topics. The first course for the year will be held on Saturday 1 April, and will help participants identify and develop their gifts. We are also excited to invite our church members to attend lectures in the scripture, theology, and the principles of pastoral ministry by Peter Christofides and Mick Stringer. These classes will be held on Thursdays during the school terms and enrolments will be taken until the end of January 2017.

Cambodia Mission Trip

In early January a team of 9 people from MPBC travelled to Phnom Penh to spend time at the MPBC Centre 16, serving both the trainers and the children. We taught at the Centre, interacted with staff and children, played games, read stories, did craft activities and told Bible stories. The children's English is improving and both they and the trainers love to practice their language skills. They are always excited when sponsors from Australia visit and photos of sponsors are highly valued. Visiting some of the sponsored families in their homes was a humbling experience but well received by the families. Centre Manager Somany is doing a great job, and is now starting up 'Connect Groups' with the parents who gather on 'rice' days and at other times which is creating a better community feeling for the Centre. As usual, the group was blessed in many ways and we feel we received more than we gave.
