Ignite Prayer

It was fantastic to see around 60 people of different ages come together to pray and intercede on behalf of our church community, our city, our nation and our world. There is no doubt that we are facing major challenges on different fronts, however we can take comfort in the truth that "greater is He that is in us, than he that is in the world." There was one family from the Middle East that came and we were able to hear of their journey and offer prayer for them. It was indeed a very encouraging time. We look forward to seeing more people come and join us at the next Ignite Prayer in 2018.

Solar Panels

We have been progressively reducing our electricity consumption through the installation of LED lights, and the next phrase is to install a 40kW solar PV system on the roof of the Booragoon Campus Facility, predominantly above the Function Room. We plan to have the work completed by 31 December. The initial net capital cost to the Building Fund will be \$38k, with a payback period of 2.5 years. This is expected to create additional savings of \$15k per year on the electricity bill and cut our CO₂ emissions footprint. This will be good for the environment as well as generating cost savings for us.

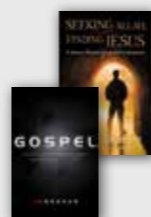
