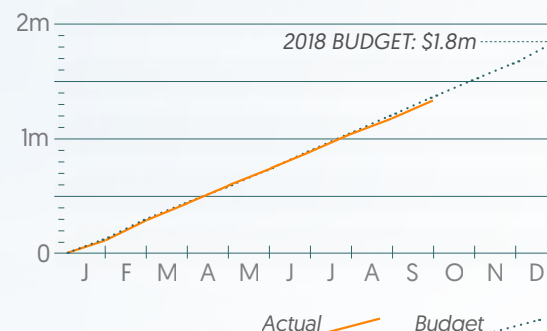

The letter of James was written by Jesus’ brother, a man who was also a key leader of the early Jerusalem church. At that time persecution was increasing and Christians in Jerusalem were scattered throughout the Roman world. James wrote to them as a concerned leader to encourage them in their faith through those difficult times. During the month of November we will be looking at some of the key themes of James. This letter is not only rich in theology, but is extremely practical in its application, hence our title, “Faith that Works.” As followers of Jesus we need a faith that sustains us not only when life is going smoothly, but a faith that is robust enough to hold fast in the more difficult seasons.
